5. Ability to interpret the work and vision of the SCM to churches and ecumenical partners;

6. Ability to provide pastoral care and support to full time staff when need arises;

7. Willingness to undertake international travel at least once a year;

8. Willingness to work with a diverse group in a committee and attend online committee meetings at least once a month

9. Committed and passionate to serve the WSCF through the Standing Committee for the next biennium 2017-2019

BASIC REQUIREMENTS FOR

Regional Women's Committee Members

- 1. SCM leadership experience at national level particularly on Women's or Gender issues/programmes
- 2. Possess the commitment to empower women and men to become holistic and inclusive being in WSCF in conjuncture with the main thrusts of the Regional Women's Programme
- 3. Possess the ability to envision the future thrust and direction of the Regional Women's Programme and
- 4. To initiate, decide, lead, facilitate and implement the planning and work of the regional women's programmes together with the Regional Women's Committee members and Regional Women's Coordinator
- 5. To provide pastoral support and care to the Regional Women's Coordinator
- 6. Involves at least one international travel during her tenure
- 7. Willingness to work with a diverse group in a committee and attend online committee meetings at least once a month
- 8. Committed and passionate to serve the WSCF through the Regional Women's Committee for the next biennium 2017-2019

BASIC REQUIREMENTS FOR

Human Rights Justice and Peace Committee Members

- 1. SCM leadership experience at national level
- 2. Awareness on Human Rights issues in their own context and committed to the Human Rights work.
- 3. Committed to spread the work of HRJP in local, national and regional level.
- 4. Willingness for international travel for the HR related programmes/ initiatives
- 5. Ability to communicate to the HRJP committee and the Global WSCF, through Advocacy and Solidarity Committee on issues related to Human Rights in the sub-region, through statements, analytical articles etc.
- 6. Committed to provide support to the committee and particularly to the HRJP Coordinator.
- 7. Willingness to work with a diverse group in a committee and attend online committee meetings at least once a month
- 8. Committed and passionate to serve the WSCF through the HRJP Committee for the next biennium 2017-2019
